

Emma Elizabeth "Betty" Sager

We note with sadness and celebration the journey's end, April 21, 2016 for our beloved Mother, Betty "TT" (Emma Elizabeth) Sager of Perryopolis, after a full life of almost 99 years. From riding horseback to school as a little girl, she experienced the lunar landing and the computer era. Born on a farm to Ellen Blair and Ollie Luce in Perryopolis in 1917, Betty was proud of her heritage and her Alma Mater, Muskingum College, where she honed her acting skills, and began her life-long interest in politics, poetry, hard work and a quest for answers to life's big questions. Her loving marriage to Mike (Harold) lasted 60 years until his death in 2000, and produced 3 children, Carol, husband Graham (Knox) Suellen (Fitzsimmons) and Jeffrey, wife Sherry, 6 grandchildren, Erin and Dave (Martin) Rachel Sager, Hilary and Will (Robinson), Molly Sager, Graham and Kelli (Knox) and Matthew and Susanne, and 8 great-grandchildren. She is also survived by her siblings, Peg Crouse (97) of Florida and Matthew(94) of Rockwood. As a lifelong member of the church her father built, and her grandfather, Rev. Matthew Blair pastored after emigrating from Scotland, Betty was a champion for fairness and justice. Mike and Betty loved spending winters in Florida, where they always welcomed family and friends, but remained loyal to their hometowns of Smithton and Perryopolis. Some of her favorite years were spent teaching school, inspiring young minds. Students loved her belief that, "Everyone wears a little sign around his neck that says, "I want to be important." Betty, the ultimate hostess, loved cooking for church dinners, Fine Arts Club, and could fashion a gourmet delivery for Meals On Wheels.
