Albert J. Stancato, Sr., 75, of N. Belle Vernon died Monday, October 17, 2005 in Mercy Hospital, Pittsburgh. A son of the late Sam and Lena Reda Stancato, he was born in Monessen on February 17, 1930. He was a member of St. Sebastian Roman Catholic Church, the Knights of Columbus, Council 3026 and the Lions Club, all of Belle Vernon. Mr. Stancato was a volunteer at Mon Valley Hospital and was awarded the Lifetime Achievement Award from the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society for his fund raising efforts over the past 10 years. His efforts have raised over \$100,000.00 through walks in marathons in Bermuda, Honolulu, London, Ireland, Paris, Athens, Venice, Alaska, Sweden, Berlin and Amsterdam. Al was a U.S. Army veteran of the Korean Conflict and had received a Bronze Medal in the Senior Olympic Games. Survivors include 2 daughters and sons-in-law, Debbie and Marshall Boyd of Daytona Beach, FL and Monica and John Kimbler of Pembroke Pines, FL, 2 sons and a daughter-in-law, Albert and Diane Stancato of Fishers, IN and Chris Stancato of Davie, FL, 1 sister, Angeline Grimes of Gary, IN, 2 brothers, Frank Stancato of Belle Vernon and Lou Stancato of Long Island, NY and 2 grandchildren, Parker and Keaton Stancato.
