Anthony E. 'Tony' Barr, 87, of Washington Heights (Belle Vernon) went to be with the Lord on Wednesday, October 2, 2019. A son of the late Anthony and Virginia Grossi Barr, he was born in Charleroi on October 10, 1931. He was a member of the Marion Presbyterian Church, the Mon Valley Dartball League for over 55 years and was a former member of the retiree's bowling league at Brunswick Lanes. A resident of Belle Vernon for the past 56 years, he had formerly resided in Charleroi. A 1995 retiree, Tony worked in the Tube Shipping office at the Allenport Plant of Wheeling-Pittsburgh Steel Company. Tony served in the U.S. Navy during the Korean War and was an avid Pittsburgh sports teams fan. Along with his wife, Tony has had season tickets for 50 years for the Belle Vernon High School Leopard Football program.
