Arnold K. Dull, 80, of Belle Vernon, passed away on Monday, March 8, 2021. A son of the late Joseph and Alverta Bulger Dull, he was born in N. Charleroi on November 5, 1940. He was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Monessen. Arnold retired from the Pennsylvania State Police in November of 1990 after serving for 30 years. He was a former President of the Fraternal Order of Police Lodge 47 of Eighty Four, PA and served on the State Police Arbitration Committee.
