Bill R. Ross, 98, of Monessen, passed away on Thursday, June 11, 2020 in Mon Valley Care Center. A son of the late Clarence Lloyd and Bessie (Sanders) Ross, he was born in Gibsonton on January 3, 1922, but lived his full life in Monessen. He had been employed by the John L. Gibson Garage in Monessen until he opened his own Auto Repair Shop in 1950 at First and Donner Avenue. Bill was a veteran of WWII, a staff sergeant serving as a Radio operator on a E47 Aircraft during the European theater. He was a lifetime member of the Monessen Elks Lodge #773, over 50 years with American Legion Post #28, also the V.F.W. Post 1190, and was a member of the First United Methodist Church of Monessen. He is survived by a very special friend, Betty Jean Byron and numerous nieces and nephews. 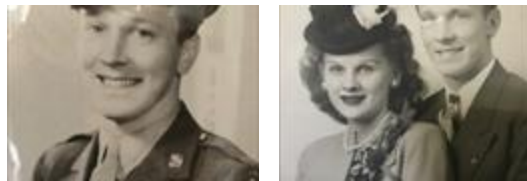
