Carl L. Neil, 87, died in Greensburg on Wednesday, February 9, 2022 after a courageous battle with prostate cancer. He was the husband of Nancy Neil for 65 years; the father of an infant daughter, the son of Clyde and Yolanda Pesi Neil; and the brother of Clyde E. Neil. Carl was born on February 6, 1935 in N. Belle Vernon, which was always home to him. He graduated from Bellmar High School (Belle Vernon Area School District). After his service in the Army, he attended Point Park College in Pittsburgh and graduated with an Associate Degree in Accounting. His twenty-eight years of employment were in the Bessemer Lake Erie Railroad and subsequent U.S. Steel Railroad offices in Pittsburgh and Monroeville. Carl was a former member of the Elks Lodge in Latrobe where he enjoyed golfing with friends. Hunting and fishing were favorite pastimes.
