Charles ""Buzzy"" Fetterman, 69, of Fayette City, died Tuesday, August 9, 2005 at his residence. Born April 11, 1936 in Cleveland, Ohio, he was the son of the late Clifford and Elizabeth Riley Fetterman. He had been a resident of Fayette City for the past 30 years.
