Charles "Chuck" Woss, 63, of Rostraver Township, passed away on Wednesday, April 1, 2020 after a one year battle with several health issues. A son of the late James and Eleanor Marsoli Heffran and Charles Stanley Woss, he was born in N. Charleroi on March 1, 1957. Chuck had been employed as a Regional Sales Manager by Liberty Engineered Wire Products for the past 6 years, but had worked in the steel industry and sales his whole life. 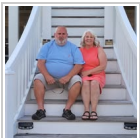
