Conrad (Connie) J. Stinogle, 72, devoted husband, father, and grandfather, went to be with his Lord and Savior on Monday, January 1, 2018. Mr. Stinogle was a resident of North Belle Vernon and Vanderbilt, PA. He was the son of Conrad W. and Juanita Stinogle and the grandson of Nancy Sholes of Burnsville, West Virginia with whom he made his home for many years. He was a member of the First Christian Church of Belle Vernon, the Belle Vernon American Legion Post 659, Moose 209, and the Belle Vernon V.F.W Post 699. He retired from the Wheeling-Pittsburgh Steel Coke Plant in Monessen and the U.S. Army corp. of Engineers. A Vietnam war veteran, he also retired from the U.S. Army and PA Army National Guard with a combined honorable service of 27 years, receiving a purple heart. Conrad enjoyed hunting, fishing, scuba diving, reading, camping, and visiting Civil War Battlegrounds. He also volunteered as an EMT and conducted CPR classes for the American Red Cross.
