Dale G. "Babe" Weightman, 83, of Belle Vernon, passed away on Thursday, March 11, 2021 in Southmont of Presbyterian SeniorCare, Washington. The son of the late Thomas and Clara Hildebrand Weightman, he was born in N. Charleroi on July 11, 1937. A lifelong resident of Belle Vernon, Dale was a member of First United Methodist Church of Belle Vernon, East Belle Vernon Athletic Club, Musical Society of Belle Vernon, and the Belle Vernon Lions Club. In 2002, Babe was inducted into the Belle Vernon Area Football Hall of Fame. He was a self-employed contractor for 30 years until his retirement in 2005.
