



Dalvert 'Skip' Booth

September 22, 1926 - February 15, 2013

Dalvert W. 'Skip' Booth, 86, of N. Belle Vernon, went to be with Lord on Friday, February 15, 2013. A son of the late Clarence O. Booth and Jessie Campbell Booth Kendall, he was born on September 22, 1926 in N. Charleroi. Skip was a past president and life member of the N. Belle Vernon Volunteer Fire Department, a former member of the Belle Vernon Lions Club and had been a Scout Master in the 1960's of Troop 541. A resident of N. Belle Vernon for most of his adult life, he formerly worked with TWA in Washington, DC, as a part-time police officer in N. Belle Vernon and then worked for 24 years for Columbia Gas Co., retiring in 1981. He served as a Boatswains Mate on the USS Oregon City with the U.S. Navy during World War II. Survivors include his wife of 63 years, Doris M. Zuro Booth, two sons and daughters-in-law, Dalvert D. and Brenda Booth of Millsboro, Delaware and Doug D. and Jan Booth of Daisytown, one sister, Lila Nichols of Belle Vernon and three grandchildren, Adam W. Booth of Baltimore, MD, Cori Booth of Millsboro, DE, and Andy Booth, a student at W & J College, of Daisytown. 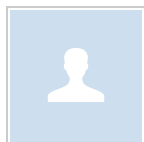
