Dorothy Ivy Vickers Leasure, of Belle Vernon (Lynnwood), passed away peacefully in her home with her loving family at her side on Friday, July 15, 2011. Born June 14, 1920 in Derby England, she was the only child of John Thomas Vickers and Gladys Revell Vickers Bloice. A homemaker, Dorothy studied nursing in London, England, and worked treating injured civilians and allied troops during World War II. Her patients referred to her as "Sunshine". She came to the United States after marrying her husband, George Leasure, and became a U.S. citizen in 1951. She was an active member of the First United Methodist Church of Belle Vernon, belonging to the United Methodist Women, Ruth Circle and the Eastern Star Lodge 205 (Monessen).
