Eli F. Myers, Jr., 87, of Webster died Thursday, July 23, 2009 in his home. A son of the late Eli F. Myers Sr. and Marie Josephine Kmetz Myers, he was born in Star Junction on September 4, 1921. On March 22, 1952 he married Jean Boulton Myers. with whom he celebrated 54 years of marriage prior to her death on November 2, 2006.
