Esther Trozzo, 93, of Uniontown, PA passed away peacefully surrounded by her loving family on Friday, December 13th 2024.

Freshly baked bread, homemade pasta sauce, and cookies were staples of her hospitality, a tradition she maintained for decades. Her faith was a guiding light throughout her life, and she had a profound devotion to Our Blessed Mother, whose influence shaped her nurturing heart and tireless commitment to her family.
