



Ferdinand 'Fred' Tonarelli

July 29, 1937 - November 20, 2014

Ferdinand A. (Fred 'Junior') Tonarelli, 77, passed away peacefully in his sleep at Southwestern Nursing Center, Pleasant Hills, on Thursday, November 20, 2014 after a year long illness. A son of the late Ferdinand and Clara Traversari Tonarelli, he was born in Dunlevy on July 29, 1937. He was a member of St. Sebastian Roman Catholic Church, the Washington Twp.
