



## Frank L. Britt

May 30, 1943 - October 31, 2020

Frank L. Britt, 77, of Monongahela (Forward Twp.), passed away on Saturday, October 31, 2020 in his home. A son of the late James E. and Rose P. Porter Britt, he was born in Martins Ferry, OH on May 30, 1943. Frank was a member of the Belle Vernon American Legion, Post 659, and served in the U.S. Army during Vietnam. He was an avid motorcyclist having Harley and Honda touring cycles. Frank, and his wife Patty, have ridden to all 48 contiguous states, the last trip taking them to Glacier National Park in Montana. He loved working on cars with his daughters and late grandson, Chance. His favorites were classic cars, and especially his 1967 Chevy Chevelle.
