



## Frank Delia

January 1, 1918 - December 30, 2020

Frank Delia, 102, of Belle Vernon, passed away on Wednesday, December 30, 2020 in Country Care Manor. A son of the late Joseph and Filomenia DeFazio Delia, he was born in Mt. Sterling, PA on January 1, 1918. Frank was a member of St. Sebastian Roman Catholic Church of Belle Vernon, the Holy Name Society and the Knights of Columbus. A lifelong resident of Belle Vernon, Frank was employed by the former American Window Glass Company of Belle Vernon and retired in 1983 from the Monessen Plant of Wheeling-Pittsburgh Steel Company after 27 years of service. He served during World War II, U.S. Army, Technician 4th grade, serving in Europe where he received five bronze stars and was awarded the French Legion of Honor in November 2020, and was a 75 year member of the Belle Vernon American Legion, Post 659. Survivors include one daughter, Linda J. Delia of Uniontown, and one son, Eugene F. Delia of Belle Vernon. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Mary Brizzi Delia, two sisters, Mary Zeli and Rose Delia, and two brothers, James and Joseph Delia.
