Franklin J. Reppert, 94, of Washington Twp., Belle Vernon, went to be with the Lord on Saturday, January 30, 2021 in Country Care Manor. A son of the late Paul C. and Myrtle Zundel Reppert, he was born in Belle Vernon on January 19, 1927. A resident of Belle Vernon most of his adult life, he was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Belle Vernon and the Belle Vernon American Legion Post 659. A U.S. Army veteran, he served in the 8th Calvary Infantry during World War II in the Philippines and Japan, where he was present for the signing of the Peace Treaty. Prior to operating his own business, Frank worked as a bricklayer, was employed at the Newell Chemical Plant, gas station attendant, grave digger and worked a short time in the Allenport Steel Mill. He had been self-employed for 60 years for Reppert Heating and Cooling, retiring 20 years ago. Frank was an avid bowler at Brunswick and the former Lynnwood Lanes. He is survived by a daughter, Darla Garrett of Belle Vernon, a son and daughter in-law, James and Kathy Reppert of Speers, three grandchildren, Chris (Katelyn) Garrett, Jeremy (Heidi) Reppert, and Jeffrey (Julie) Reppert, one great granddaughter, Josie Reppert, and many nieces and nephews.
