January 17, 1933 - January 30, 2016

G. Thomas Fee, 83, formerly of Washington Township (Belle Vernon), went to be with the Lord on Saturday, January 30, 2016 in Syracuse, New York. A son of the late George and Ann Graham Fee, he was born in Belle Vernon on January 17, 1933. Tom was a member of Pricedale Union Church and the Pitt Golden Panthers. He graduated from the University of Pittsburgh in 1954 with a degree in Pharmacy. He also served as a board member for the Belle Vernon Area Hall of Fame Committee. Tom was the owner and operator of Fee's Pharmacy in Fayette City for over 30 years until his retirement in 1999. He was an avid sports fan and enjoyed spending time with his grandchildren. Survivors include his wife of 54 years, Frances Ann Reed Fee; two daughters, Beth Linger of Liverpool, New York and Catherine Ann Fee of New Jersey; two brothers and three sisters-in-law, James (Carol) Fee of Monongahela, Samuel (Pat) Fee of Charleroi, and Nancy Reed of Belle Vernon; two grandchildren, Brian Linger of Saratoga Springs, New York and Caitlyn Fee of New Jersey. 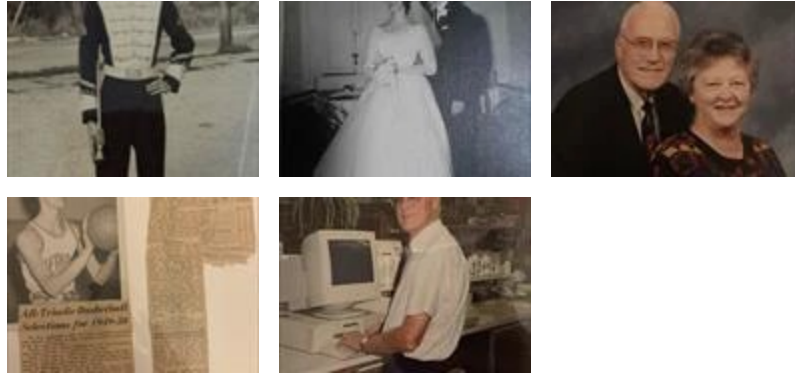
