George W. 'Buck' Adams, 75, of N. Belle Vernon died suddenly on Wednesday, July 23, 2008. A son of the late George K. and Helen Mae Lehew Adams, he was born in N. Belle Vernon on March 14, 1933 and graduated from the former Vernon High School in 1951. He was a member of St. Sebastian Roman Catholic Church, the Mon Valley A.R.C. and the N.A.L.C. He was a former member of the Belle Vernon Volunteer Fire Company #2 and more recently volunteered at the St. Vincent DePaul Society in Monessen. A U.S. Navy veteran, he served during the Korean Conflict.
