Harry C. Ellison "Pap", 91, of Belle Vernon, after a short bout with cancer, went to be with Jesus on Tuesday, January 11, 2022 at home surrounded by his family. The son of the late Harry V. and Hilda Dean Ellison was born in N. Charleroi on August 10, 1930. A resident of Belle Vernon since 1954, Harry was a member of the National Management Association, a lifelong member of the First United Methodist Church of Belle Vernon, and most recently attended the Gospel Alliance Church in Rostraver Twp. with his son and family with whom he was residing. He was an avid bowler and golfer, belonging to several leagues. He also enjoyed going to the YMCA and Planet Fitness.
