Jack H. Mood, age 90, of Fayette City, died October 6, 2012, peacefully surrounded by family, at his home. A son of the late Gust and Lilly Glotfelty Mood, he was born March 6, 1922. Besides his parents, he is preceded in death by his first wife Delma Atkinson Mood and infant daughter who both died during childbirth; brothers Walter and Ed Mood and sister Evelyn Renstrom.
