Joseph B. Karbowsky, 77, of Allenport, fell asleep in the Lord on Thursday, March 30, 2017 in Mon Valley Hospital. A son of the late Joseph M. and Mary Petros Karbowsky, he was born in Monessen on August 8, 1939. Joseph served his country in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam Conflict.
