Kenneth S. Culbertson, 65, of N. Charleroi, passed away Monday, February 13, 2017. A son of the late Walter and Lois J. Dawson Culbertson, he was born in Belle Vernon on February 12, 1952. He was a member of the East Monongahela Sportsmen's Club and participated in the "Hunt of a Lifetime" with underprivileged children. Ken was the assistant high school football coach, athletic director since July 1, 2016, substitute teacher for over 15 years, all within the Frazier School District, where the students and athletes referred to him as "Coach Ken." He ran the Pittsburgh marathon two times.
