Lawrence J. 'Fuzzy' Morozek, 91, of Belle Vernon, formerly of Fayette City passed away on Saturday, October 9, 2021 in Greensburg at the Rehabilitation and Nursing Center of Greater Pittsburgh. A son of the late Steve and Mae Butler Morozek, he was born in Smock on March 13, 1930.
