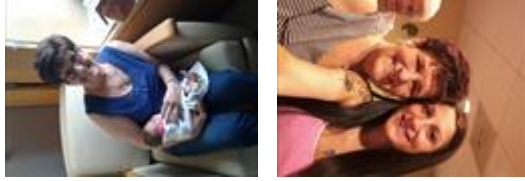
July 10, 1943 - November 9, 2016
