Marion S. Breakwell, 88, of Belle Vernon, passed away on Thursday, November 12, 2020 in the Baldwin Health Center. A daughter of the late Merwin G. and Elizabeth Bates Shryock, she was born in Erie on July 31, 1932. Marion was a member of the Fells United Methodist Church, had been active for many years with various bridge clubs and, when her children were younger, was an active hockey mom. She was a founding member and one of the first Paramedics for the former Rostraver Emergency Medical Service and had been a substitute teacher in the Belle Vernon Area School District.
