Mary C. Malenowski, 92, formerly of Washington Twp. (Fairhope), passed away peacefully on September 28, 2023. The daughter of the late Robert H. and Lillian Momberger Gill, she was born in Elco on July 2, 1931 and was the last surviving member of her family.
