February 12, 1919 - December 10, 2010

Mitchell Weckoski, 91, formerly of Clover Hill, passed away Friday, December 10, 2010 in Mon Valley Hospital. A son of the late Joseph and Sophia Duda Weckoski, he was born in Charleroi on February 12, 1919. A member of St. Lukes Roman Catholic Church of Bentleyville, he had graduated from the Bentleyville High School in 1936 and served three years in the U.S. Army during World War II, two of those years as a surgical technician in the South Pacific. A farm hand, coal miner and foundry molder, he was also a wire drawer for the former Page Plant in Monessen, and retired in 1982 from the Allenport Plant of Wheeling-Pittsburgh Steel Company, having worked as a foreman in the sheet mill. Survivors include one daughter and son-in-law, Deborah and Thomas Guerra, of Long Branch, with whom he had made his home for the past one year, two sons and a daughter-in-law, Barry Weckoski of Cypress, CA and Daniel and Denise Weckoski of Monessen, two brothers and a sister-in-law, Albert and Mary Weckoski and Edwin Weckoski, all of Clover Hill, and one granddaughter, Marcy Lynn Guerra of LaFayette, IN.
