Nicholas J. Pavlick, 75, of Rostraver Twp, passed away on Monday, July 14, 2025 at Jefferson Hospital. A son of the late Nicholas and Mary (Kotuba) Pavlick, he was born in Pittsburgh on May 26, 1950.

Nick was a resident of Belle Vernon for the past 46 years. He was a very active and dedicated member of the Bible Chapel, Rostraver campus, and he loved sharing his faith and the joy it brought him with anyone he met. He graduated from the former California University of Pennsylvania with an Elementary Teaching degree in 1973, and, in 1977, received another degree in Environmental Sciences. He worked at the Volkswagen plant in New Stanton for 10 years before he embarked on a second career as a Physical Therapist Assistant at numerous facilities, retiring in 2016.
