December 29, 1938 - March 31, 2007

Patrick G. Connors, 68, of Pittsburgh, formerly of Monongahela, died Saturday, March 31, 2007 in Forbes Hospice. A son of the late James F. and Catherine Best Connors, he was born in Brooklyn, New York on December 29, 1938. Catholic by faith, he had resided in Pittsburgh for the past 4 years. Patrick was the Pennsylvania Youth Director, Squire Chairman West, District Deputy 109 of the Knights of Columbus and was a writer of history. He published a series of books entitled Historic Towns, a series about Southwestern Pennsylvania communities.
