



Rande J. Stottlemeyer

February 24, 1955 - January 28, 2018

Rande J. Stottlemeyer, 62, of Charleroi went to be with the Lord on January 28th, in his home, surrounded by his family after a long battle with Early Onset Alzheimer's. A son of the late Kenneth and Betty Magnus Stottlemeyer, he was born in Glendale, West Virginia on February 24, 1955. Rande attended The Bible Chapel of South Hills and loved wrestling, hunting, fishing, and being a dad. He graduated from the University of Pittsburgh in 1978 with a BS degree in Physical Education and was also the wrestling coach for the University of Pittsburgh from 1978 until his retirement in 2013. Fondly known as 'Coach' by the thousands of wrestlers he coached at Pitt, camps, and clubs, Rande was a 2-time Jr. National Freestyle Champion, and a 3-time NCAA All-American. Rande served in several offices including President of the National Wrestling Coaches Association, and Chairman of the Division I NCAA Rules Committee for wrestling. Survivors include his wife of 35 years, Regina (Carson) Stottlemeyer; four daughters and three sons-in-law, Tara Stottlemeyer at home, Rebecca (Rick) Bergstedt of Swansboro, NC, Jaclyn (Daniel) Royall of South Strabane, and Kelsey (Jesse) Pust of Fallowfield Township; three brothers and sisters-in-law, Dr. Keith (Sarah) Stottlemeyer of Riverside, CA, Ken (Sandee) Stottlemeyer of Hermitage, and Rex (Caroline) Stottlemeyer of Virginia Beach, VA; and one sister, Jan Stottlemeyer of Tequesta, Florida. . In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a son Sean in 1983 and a sister-in-law Susan in 1997.
