Richard David (Dick) Kujawski, 78, of Speers, passed away on Saturday, February 7, 2026 at Presbyterian Hospital in Pittsburgh after complications from a serious illness. He was the son of the late Henry Kujawski and June Kujawski, who survives him, of Charleroi, PA. He was born and raised in Charleroi and graduated from Charleroi Area High School in 1966. He excelled as an exceptional athlete, especially in football and received several awards for this. He attended the University of Kentucky on a football scholarship and later transferred to California University, PA. He was employed for 40 years at Wheeling Pittsburgh Steel at Allenport until 2008 when the mill closed.

In addition to his mother, Dick is survived by his wife of 46 years, Lorri Jo (Cutter) Kujawski and son Jacob, his wife Jennifer, and granddaughter Addison of Rostraver Twp.
