“ I knew Bobby for over 20 years. He was one in a million and my family and I will miss him

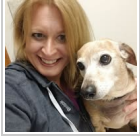

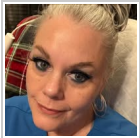

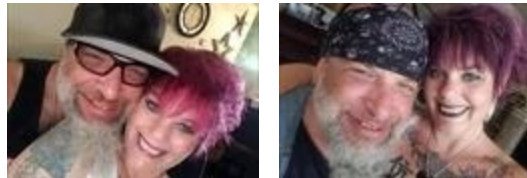
