Roger L. Grandy, 89, of Speers, passed away Tuesday, September 2, 2014 in the Hallsworth House, Monessen. A son of the late George and Josephine Barbouse Grandy, he was born in Dunlevy on February 23, 1925. He was a member of the Christ Lutheran Church of Charleroi, the Charleroi American Legion, Post 22, where he had served as commander and secretary, the Charleroi Lions Club and the Charleroi Elks. Roger was a devoted member and past president of both the state and national ARC. He was also a board member of the Washington County MHMR board. He tirelessly committed himself to improving the quality of life of those with disabilities. He served on the council of Speers Boro for over 30 years and as the council president until his recent illness. He had been the owner and operator of the former B & G Distributing in Dunlevy and was a manager of government contracts for Westinghouse Electric, retiring in 1992.
