Roy F. Evans, 85, of N. Belle Vernon died Tuesday, December 13, 2005 in the Victoria House, Monessen. A son of the late Albert and Edna Costella Evans, he was born in Belle Vernon on February 25, 1920. A lifelong resident of Belle Vernon, he was a life member of the Fraternal Order of Police and the Belle Vernon Moose. Roy was an avid bowler and was a police officer for Belle Vernon Borough in the early 1940's. He retired from the Uniontown Foodland where he was the meat department manager. Mr. Evans was inducted into the BVA Football Hall of Fame in 2003 and was a sergeant in the U.S. Marines during World War # II.
