February 7, 1943 - October 31, 2010

Ruedi Kennard Stocker, 67, of Enola, PA went home to be with his Lord and Savior. He passed away Sunday, October 31, 2010 in the Lehigh Valley Health Network, Cedar Crest & I-78, Allentown, PA.
