Terry J. Trenk, 64, of North Port, Alabama, formerly of Belle Vernon passed away Friday, March 16, 2012. A son of Joseph Trenk, who survives and resides in Belle Vernon, and the late Mary Vera Trenk, he was born in Pittsburgh on July 25, 1947. A 1965 graduate of Bellmar High School, he was a U.S. Navy Corpsman serving during the Vietnam War from 1966 until 1971.
