



## Theodore Wukovich Sr.

August 2, 1933 - March 24, 2025

Theodore Wukovich, Sr., 91, of Fallowfield Township, went to be with the Lord on Monday, March 24, 2025 in Penn Highlands Mon Valley Hospital. A son of the late Mike and Mary (Heleshitz) Wukovich, he was born in VanVoorhis on August 2, 1933.

A lifelong resident of VanVoorhis, Theodore was protestant by faith. He loved to read and learn, and often enjoyed reading the Bible. Theodore was a “Jack of all trades.” He loved hunting, fishing, trapping, gardening, especially tomatoes, masonry work, working on vehicles, and rebuilding engines. He looked forward to his Saturday night card games, often serving his homemade banana bread. Theodore had been employed by U.S. Steel, Clairton Works as a Riverboat pilot, retiring in 1988. He was a U.S. Army Veteran, serving in the Korean War.
