Tracy Poskon Day, 50, of Charleroi, passed away on Thursday, June 11, 2020. A daughter of the late Jennifer Fisher Poskon and Chester (Dixie) Poskon who survives and resides in McClellantown, PA, she was born in Brownsville on September 26, 1969. Formerly of Daisytown, Tracy had been a resident of Charleroi since 1997. She was a member of Saint Sebastian Roman Catholic Church in Belle Vernon. Tracy spent several years as the C.F.D. soccer coach and was currently the assistant coach of the Charleroi Area High School Girls' Soccer team. She was a devoted hockey mom throughout all her son, Justin's, hockey years. Tracy was employed as a substitute teacher for Charleroi Area School District and had spent 26 years as a lab technician for PACE Analytical until the pandemic forced it's closure. 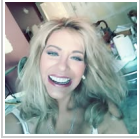

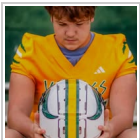

“ I wish to share my memory of the first time I met Tracy.

If I recall, it was about 1999 or 2000, when the small lab she was working for at the time merged with our lab in Harmarville. On that morning, we were asked to give tours of the facility to our newest arrivals and I was asked to give Tracy the "two cent tour". We walked around the facility from room to room, mostly chatting about the business or the types of testing we were offering. By chance we mixed in some chatter about where they were coming from, how was the drive in, what part of town you were from. At that moment, I got a good idea of whom I was dealing with.....
